First Steps for a New Believer (Orientation)

- A. Person comes forward during the Invitation at the end of the Service. The Pastor welcomes them to the congregation. The Pastor then lets the person know that they will be greeted in the classroom at the end of the service by a Deacon or Counselor.
- B. The Deacon or Counselor meets with the person in the classroom and collects information from the for the purpose of documenting what the person needs. If the person wants to become a believer the deacon or Counselor will go over the process with them.
 1). Go over the Decision/Interest Form with them
 2). Go over The Gospel with them.
- C. The Deacon or Counselor will then take to them about attending the New Believers Class that is held the first Tuesday of each month. If this day does not work, and new day/time can be agreed to with the New Member.
